1. How did you start your research?
2. Was it hard for you to prepare this set of documents?
3. What was difficult to find the documents? Did you find enough information about this topic?
4. Have you found other types of documents that could have been used? (books, magazines, reports, etc.)
5. If you could pick another document, what would you choose?
6. Why did you choose this subject?

7. Can you explain this word/ sentence?
8. What do you know about the source of the document? Is it biased?
9. Describe the picture/photo again, in detail.
10. If you had to choose a quote from the document that summarizes the main idea, what would it be?
11. How would you sum up this document in one or two sentences?
12. Could you rephrase this 'quote' from the article?
13. You didn't mention 'that part' in this document, do you think it is not relevant for your analysis?
14. You didn't compare Doc A and Doc B, do you think they have similar viewpoints?

15. Have you read about this topic in the news recently?
16. How do you think the situation is going to evolve?
17. Is this topic an important debate at the moment?
18. This document is 10 years old. Do you think it is still relevant?

19. What did you study in class about this subject or a similar theme?
