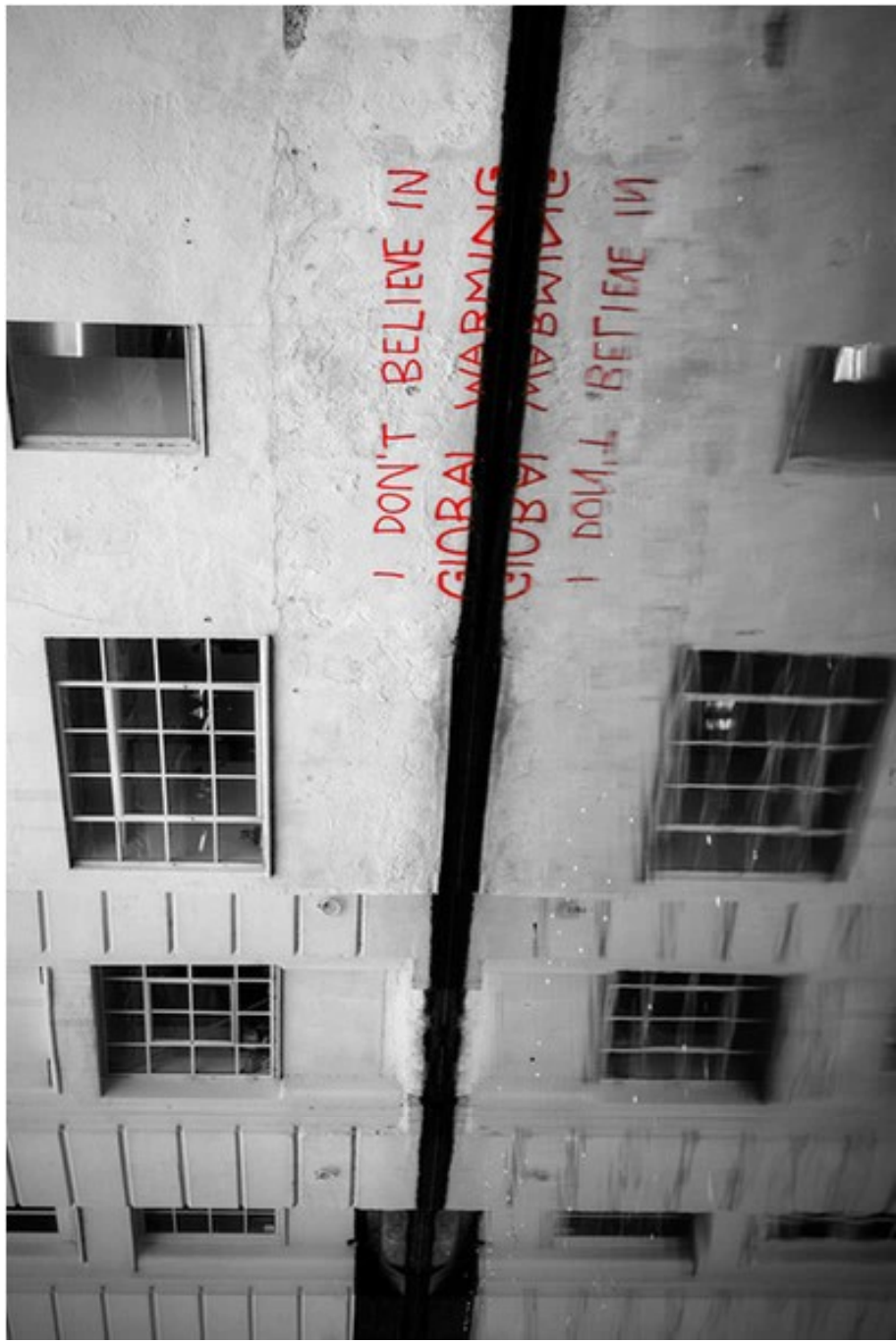

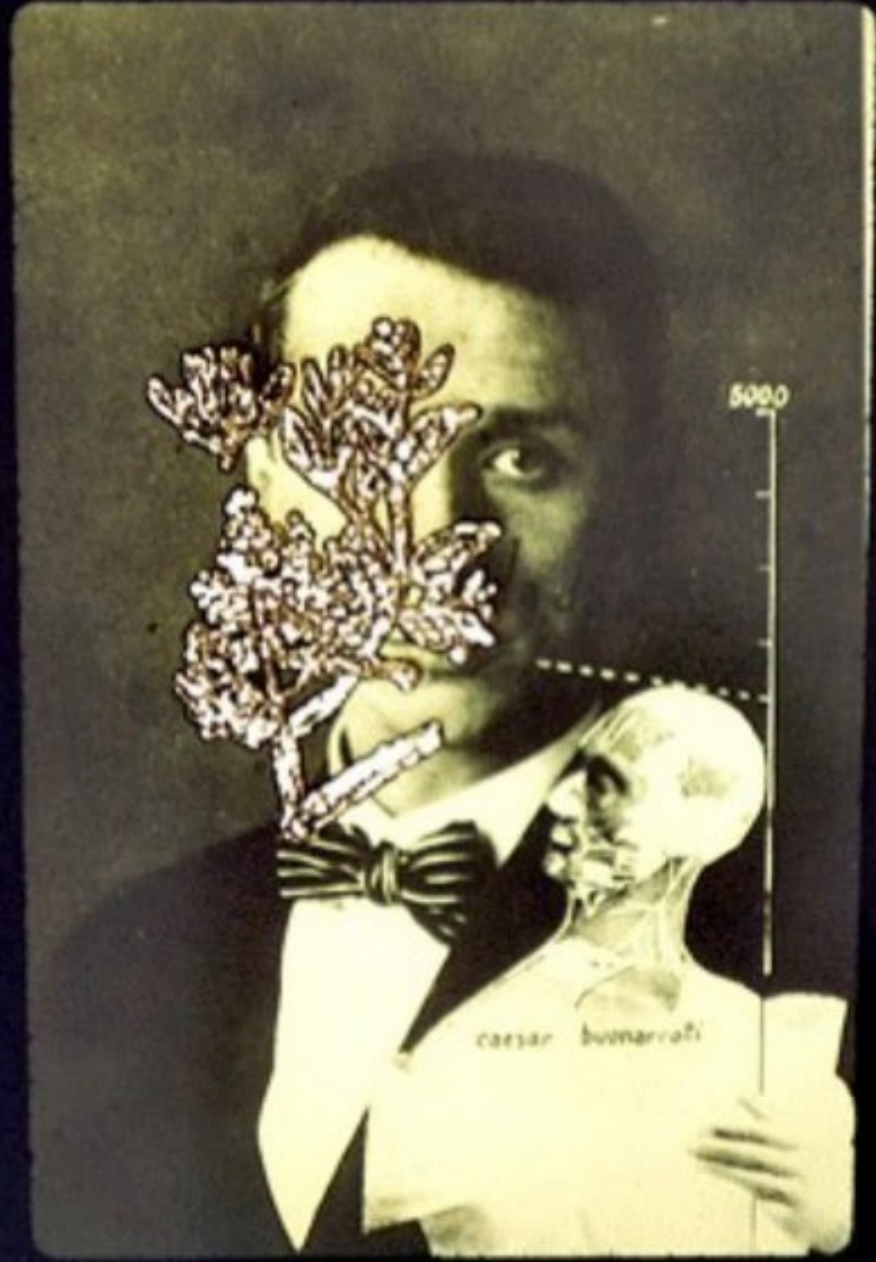


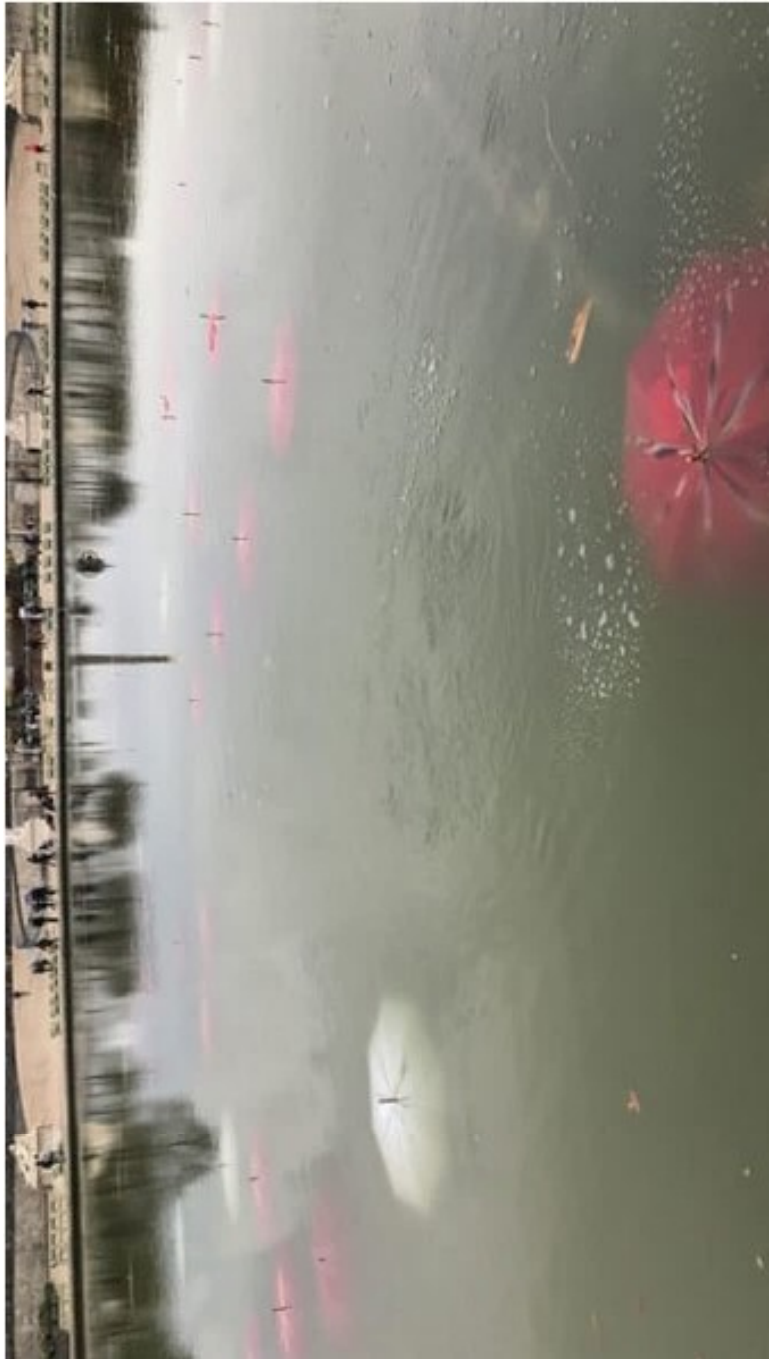
It is likely that coral reefs - described by Darwin as amongst

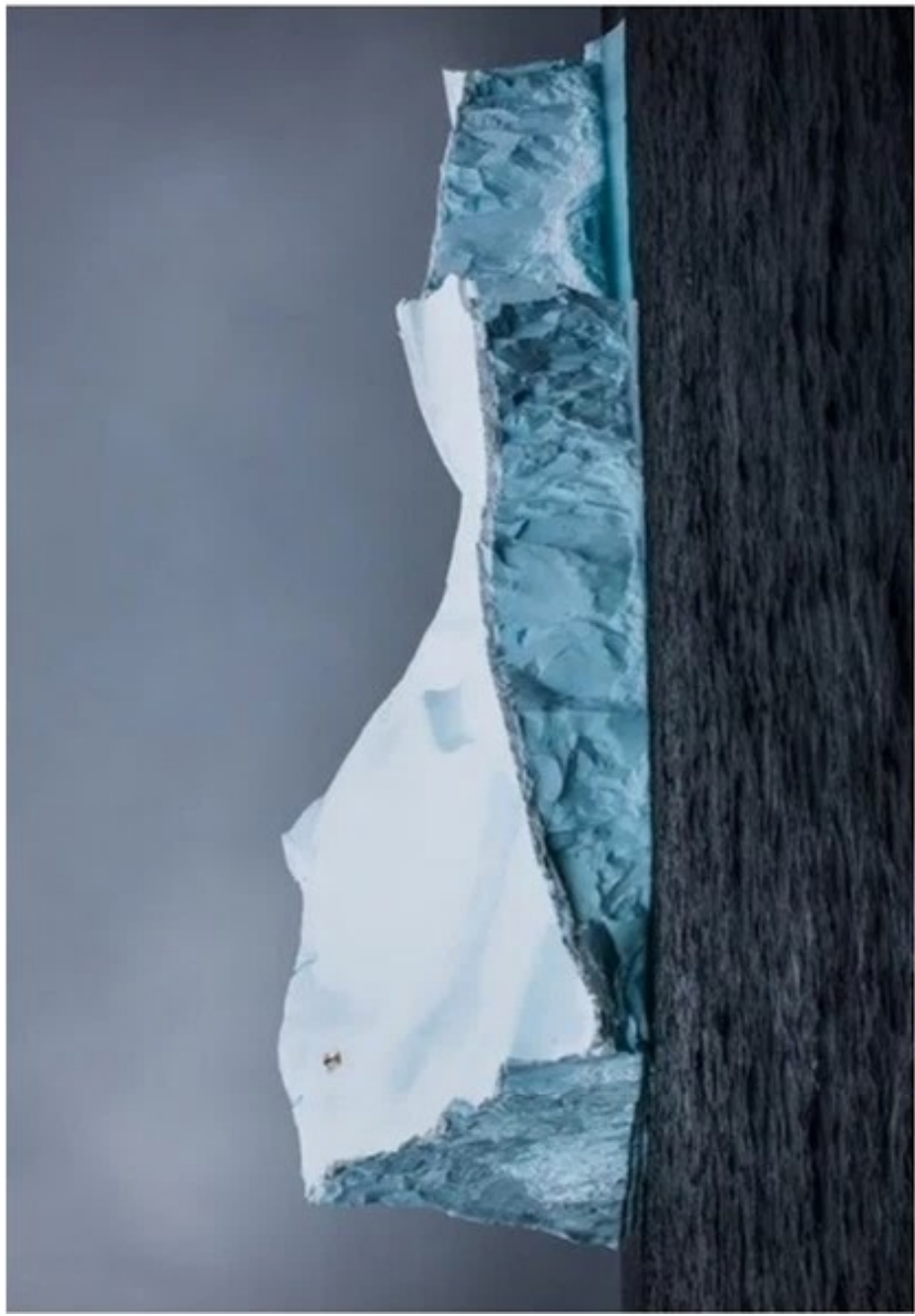








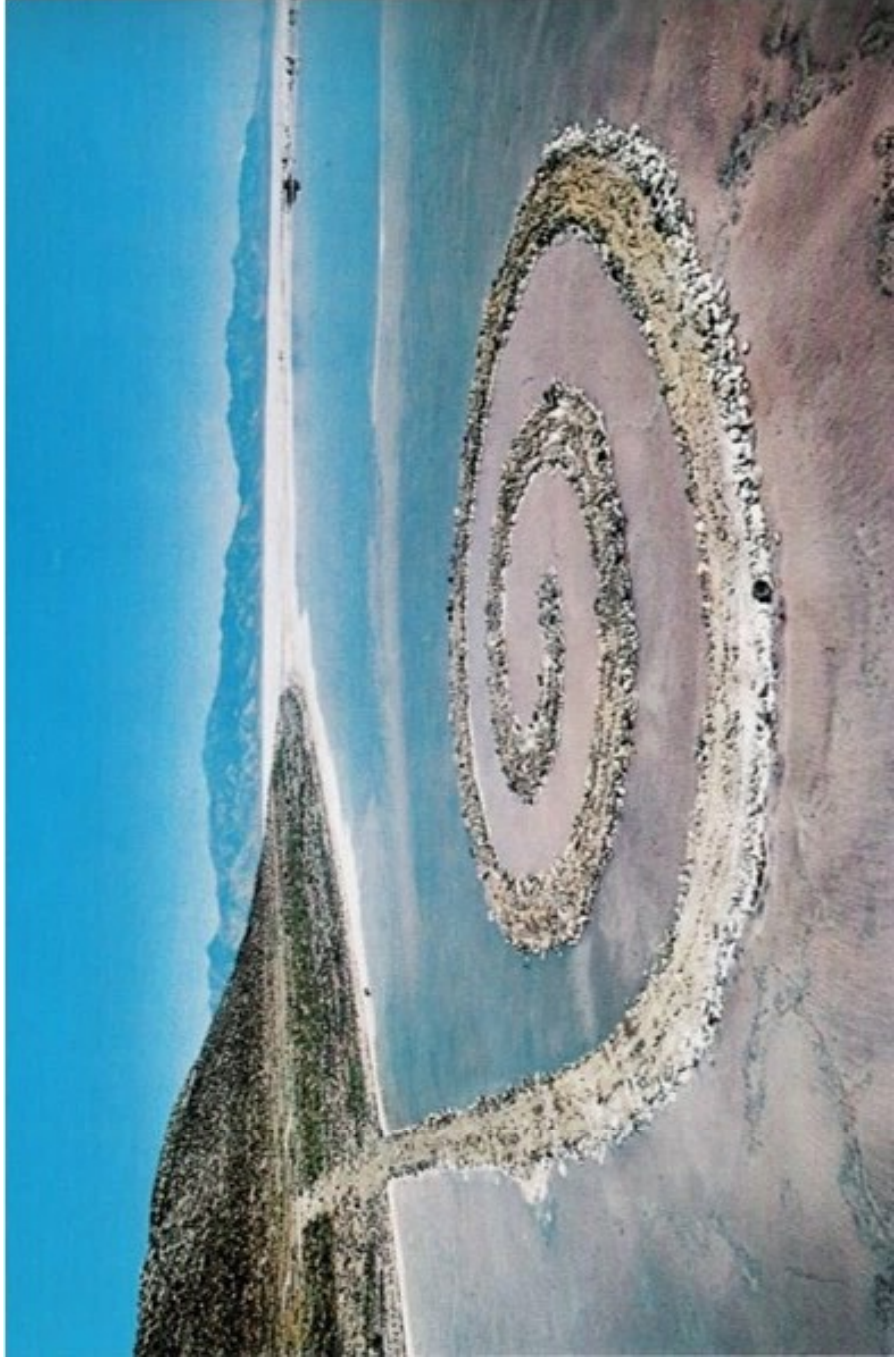
