This year Europe Day was very special for us - learners and teachers at Rakovski High School in Burgas. On this occasion, the activities carried out were varied and numerous.

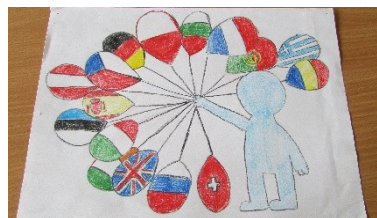
First of all, the celebration this year coincided with the Bulgarian Presidency of the Council of the European Union.

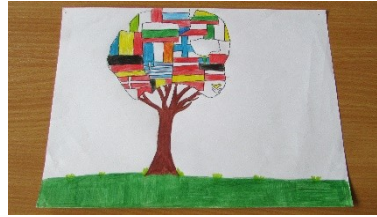
