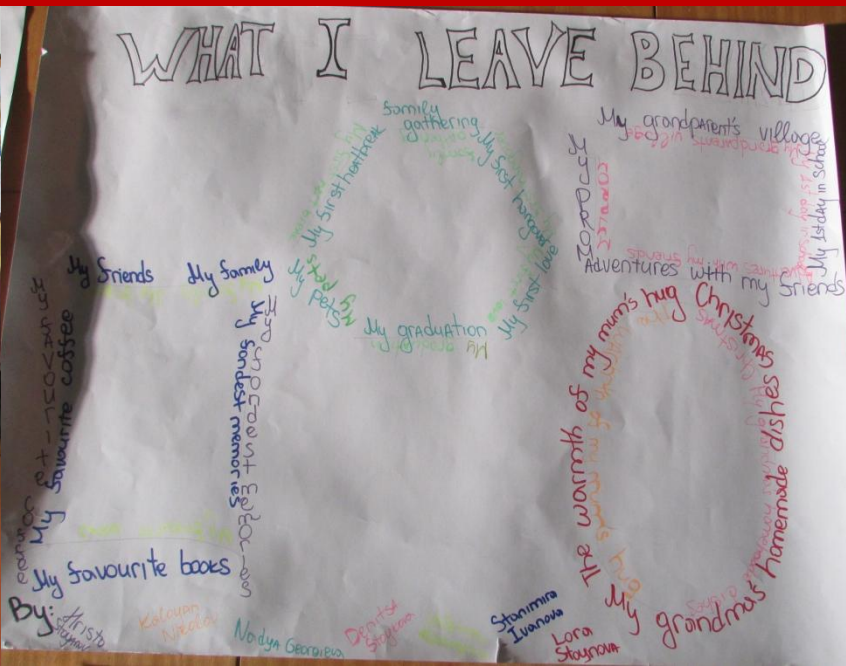

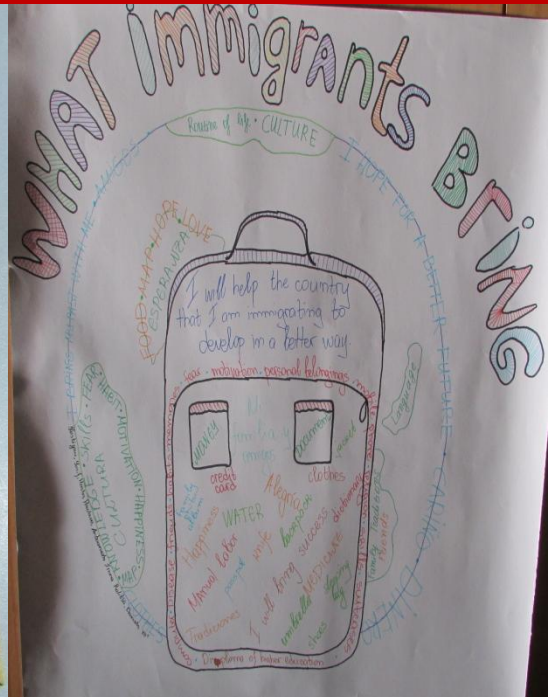
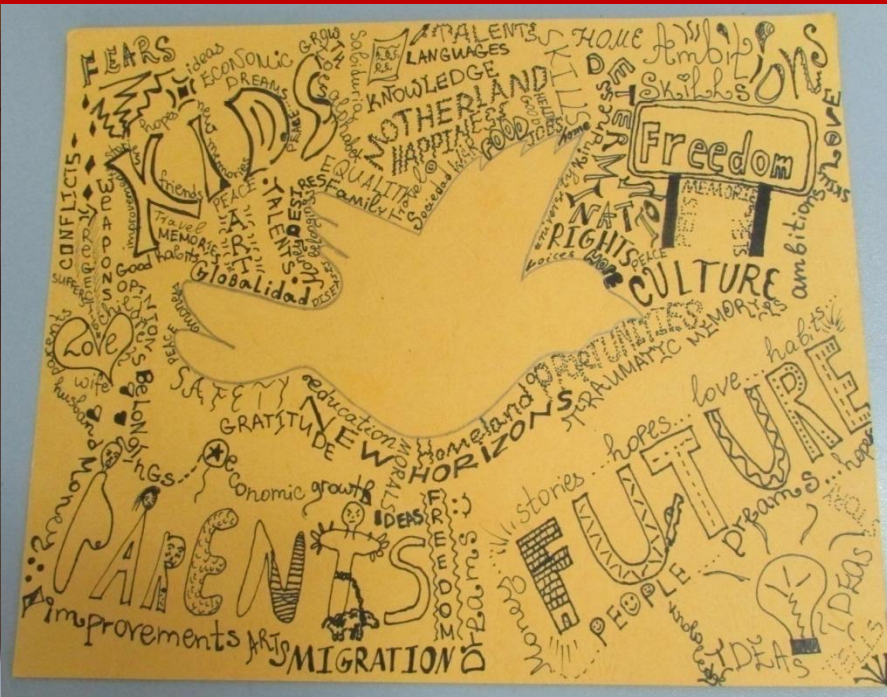

Video and quiz in Google classroom: students watch an episode from John Oliver's show *Last Week Tonight* on **Immigration Courts** and do a quiz on **quizizz.com** to check their understanding.

This is followed by a **discussion** in class on immigrant rights, used as the starting point in a lesson on debate and discussion skills
