Our hosts formed multinational teams called "Young reporters" that described and reported the everyday activities and summarised the results at the end.

The participating students created posters for the travelling exhibition in the workshops through a benefitial team work. They also interviewed migrants studying in Victor Hugo High school and explored the classroom of the future or took part in a slam concert-debate.
