

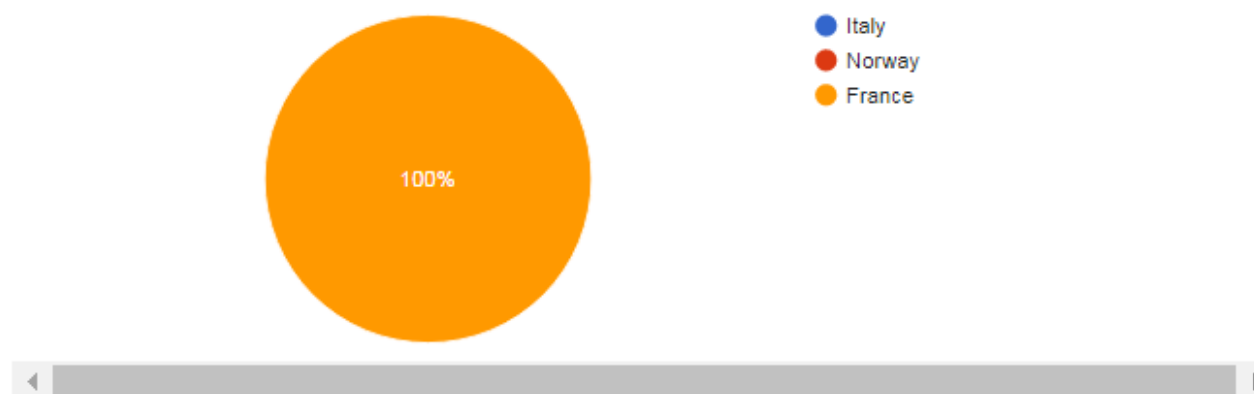

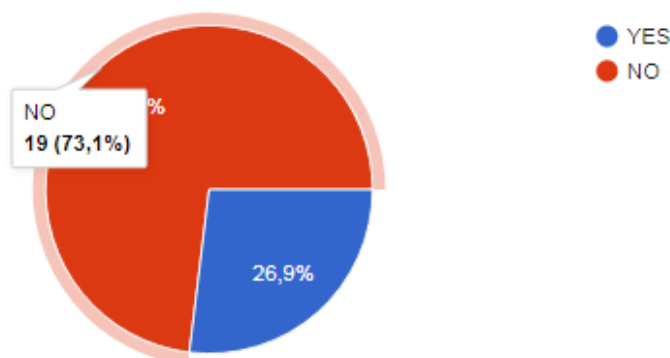
Where are you from?

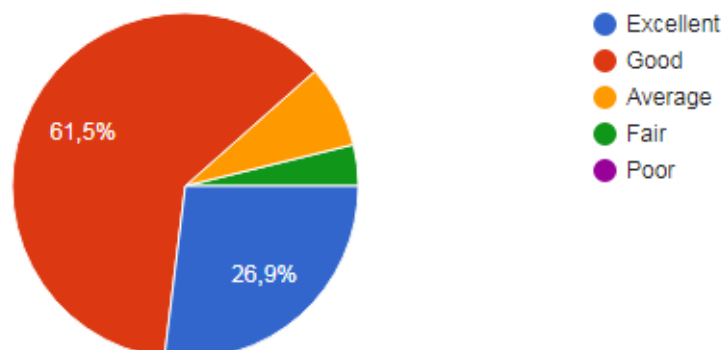
Was this your first trip abroad?

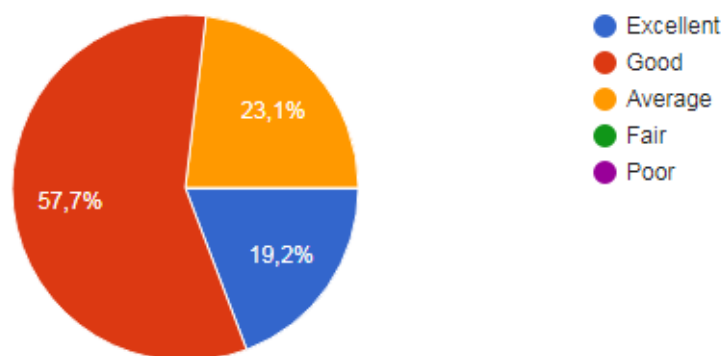
## How did you find the organization of the meeting abroad?

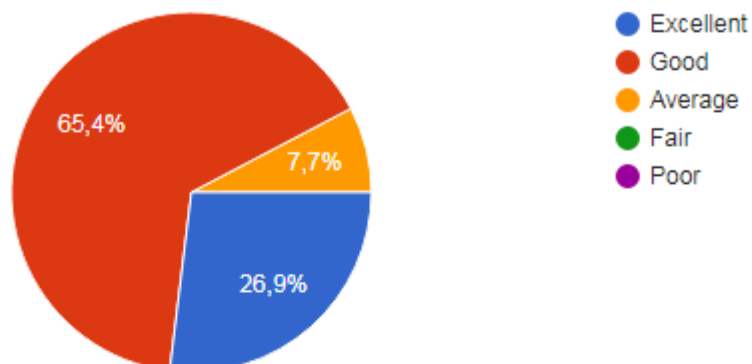
## What are your impressions of your stay: Organisation of LTT Activity:

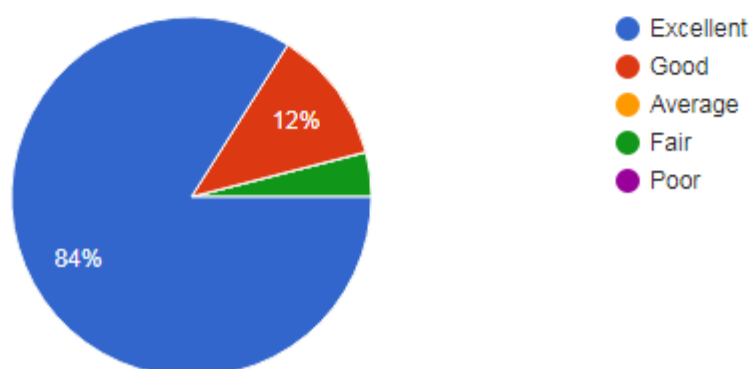
## What are your impressions of your stay : Duration of LTT Activity

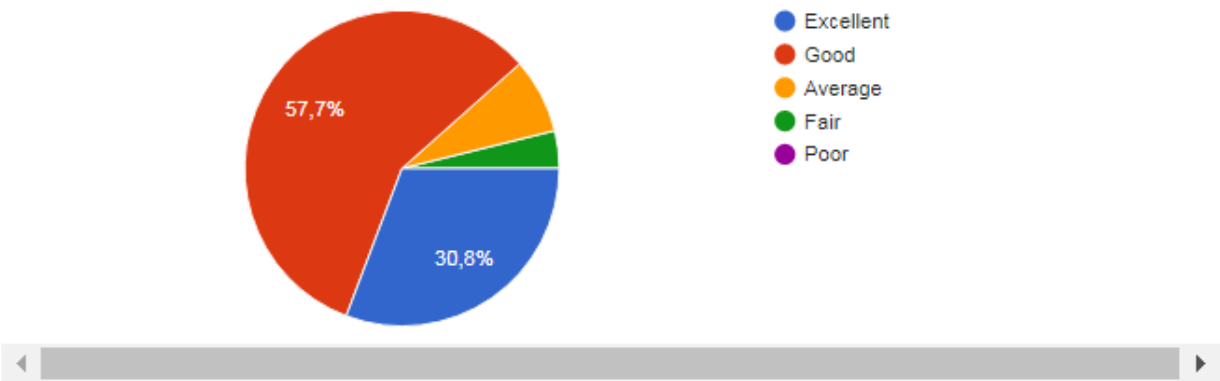

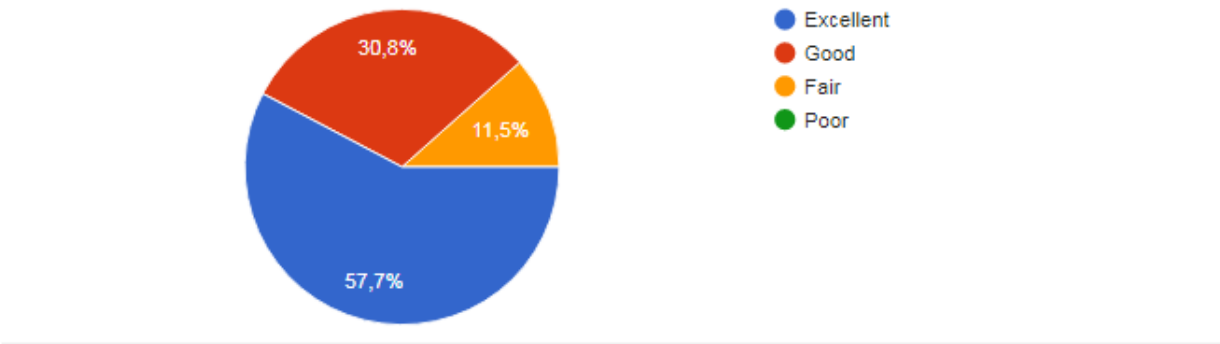

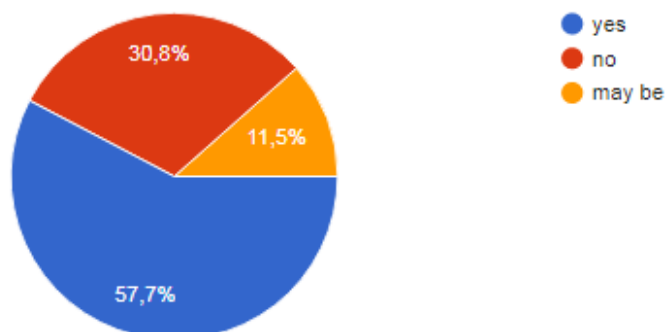

Language

The food is different and their living conditions are different

They are more friendly and open towards strangers and generally other people.

In Norwegian schools, the students and teachers are good friends. The teachers crave respect from the students, while also showing respect back. As I understood it, Bulgarian teachers are not always respectful towards their students, however, still crave respect back. That was strange to me.

More worn school building and smaller residents. Their diet is different, their dinners are larger and breakfasts are less

It looks like industrial city, there are only appartements and not houses, but the Bulgarian are amazing people

In difference from us, most live in apartments and not houses. The eating habits are different, they sell a lot of unhealthy food at school and just altogether eat a lot of sugar and dessert.

Bulgaria is very poor, the organisation of school hours are very different, the eating habits are quite different: they eat more,...

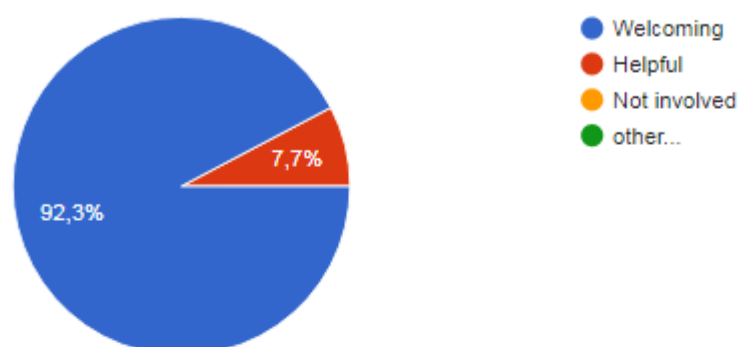

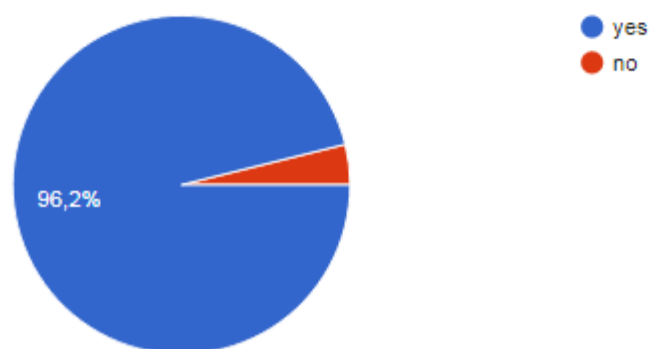

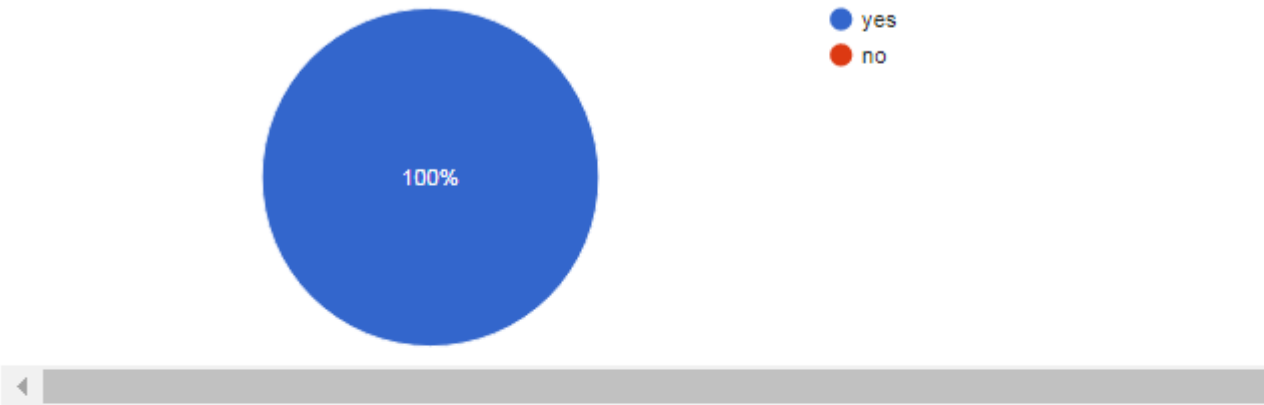

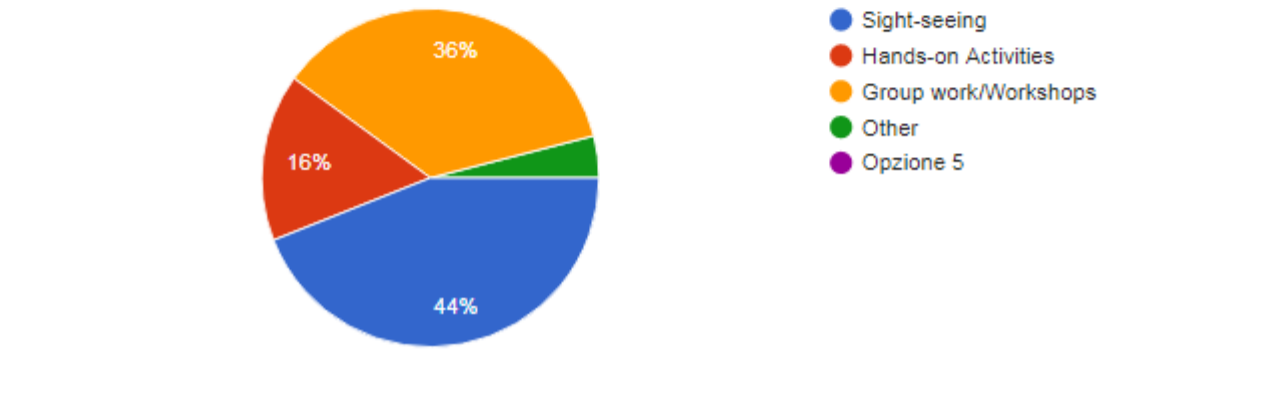

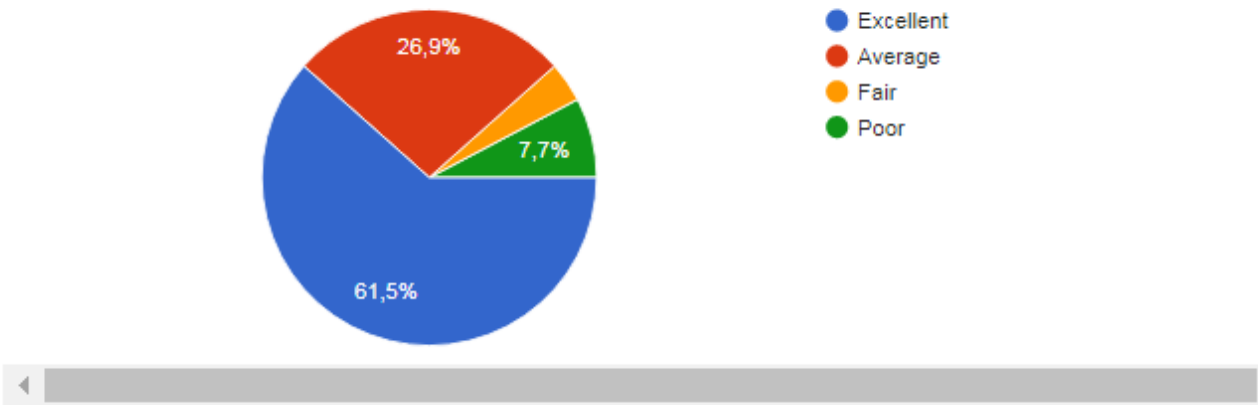
What activities would you like to see included during a similar LTT?

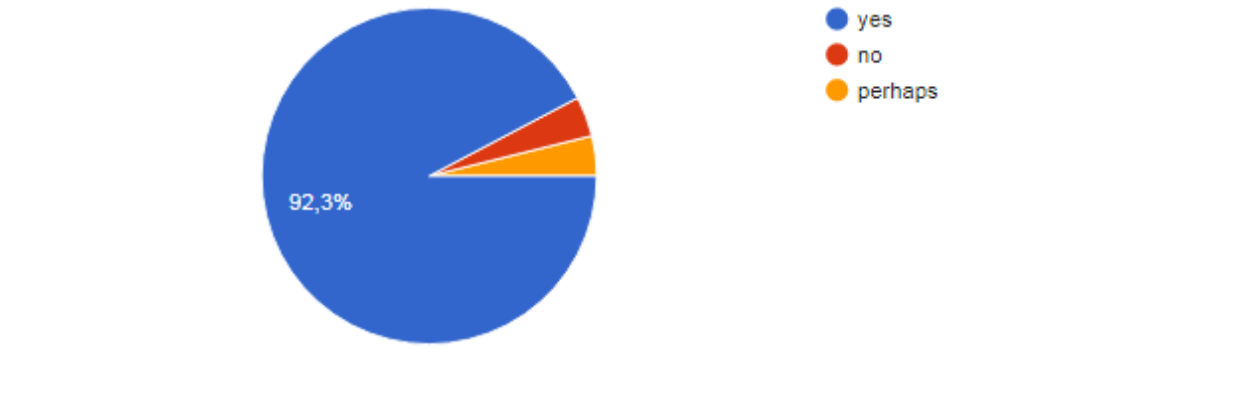
How would you rate the communication with students from other countries?

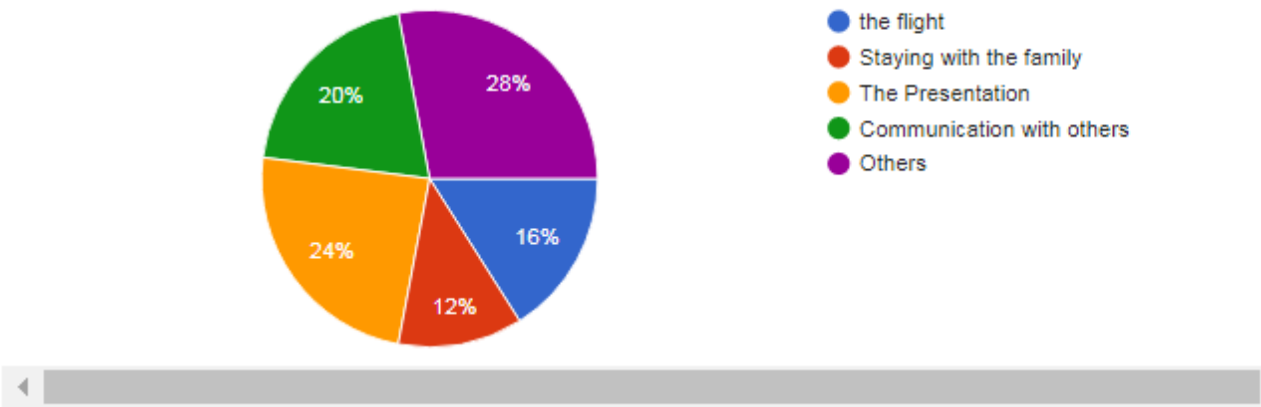
Do you think that these activities are useful to learn foreign languages?
